### 2. Treasurer's Report

- Lucas Johnson reports that the IAOS has a current balance of \$8,267.16, and there have been no major expenditures over the past year, except for the Zoom account that was needed for the International Obsidian Conference (IOC) meeting (see attachment)
- The IAOS has 96 individuals listed on the membership roll, 42 of whom are lifetime members
- This year the IAOS received 14 membership renewals, 36 new memberships, and 6 new lifetime memberships. This appears to be the largest increase in membership in about five years. The increase is likely because of the 2021 IOC

#### 2021 Annual Financial Statement for the IAOS






Figure 1. Balance over eleven years. Note: The current balance reflects a cashing out of our PayPal account as of April 25, 2021, and thus includes transactions that have been held there over the last ten years
